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### **Supplies:**

- n. 01 Cabochon Tourmaline Glass Pink/Green Oval 18 x 13 cod. CC19344;
- Delica Miyuki 11/0 Dyed Silver Lined DarkRose cod. DB 1342 (A);
- Delica Miyuki 11/0 Opaque Avocado Green cod. DB 1135 (B);
- Extra Fine Miyuki needle code TS12958;
- Nylon Miyuki Thread 0,25 Earl Grey codice SM23365;
- Scissors.

Recommended: beading mat, Cord Zap.

Level: beginner;


Tecnique: brick Stitch, flat Peyote, circular Peyote; Lenght and width (flower): 5 cm (1,96 inches);

Band lenght 7 cm (it can change depending on your finger width) - (2,75 pollici).

String n. 40 Miyuki delica 11/0 code DB 1342;



### Step 2 Fig. 2:


Close in circle and make a quare knot being sure that no any knot goes into any beads. Go through few beads and exit from one bead;






### Step 3 Fig. 3:

Make a peyote round with delica 11/0 DB 1342 - we will add n. 20 in total in this round;



#### Step 4 Fig. 4:


Exit toward the outside and make one peyote round with Rocailles 15/0 ed make the step up, (Step up in the beading world, means that after the first round we have to go through the first bead we have added, to start a new round).



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### Step 5 Fig. 5:

Make a second peyote round with Rocailles 15/0, but this time we have to skip a bead yes and a bead no;



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### Step 6 Fig. 6:

Insert the crystal cabochon and going toward the back, get ready to make the last 2 peyote rounds with Rocailles 15/0;



### Step 7 Fig. 7:

Make two peyote rounds on the back, to block up the crystal cabochon;

Make a brick stitch petal following the word chart as below, where A is Delica Miyuki 11/0 Dyed Silver Lined DarkRose cod. DB 1342: :






### Step 9 Fig. 9:

Make our flat peyote ring beading base, as for the following word chart, where Delica Miyuki 11/0 Dyed Silver Lined DarkRose cod. DB 1342 is A and Delica Miyuki 11/0 Opaque Avocado Green cod. DB 1335 is B;



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


